- Applicant must have been accepted as a student at an accredited college.
- Applicant must complete application in its entirety.  
Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Provide the last four digits of Social Security Number. Scholarships over \$750 must be reported to the IRS, and the recipient must provide the complete Social Security Number before receiving scholarship funds.

**8) PERSONAL / FAMILY / FINANCIAL HARDSHIP**

Discuss any financial or personal/familial challenges that may affect your ability to complete your education and accomplish your goals.

**9) WHY DID YOU CHOOSE YOUR MAJOR? Briefly discuss a person or issue of importance to you and how it influenced your decision on your major and goals.**

**10) LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**

**Attach letters of recommendation from two of the following: faculty or staff member of the institution you are currently attending, clergy, or employer who can attest to your character, integrity, leadership, work ethic. No letters from family members will be accepted.** Note: It is advisable to request this be returned to you well in advance of the application's due date. Also, requesting letters from three different sources ensures that you will have two ready on time.

**11) ESSAY**

Type and attach an essay of no more than one page, double spaced and using a 12 font. The essay should reflect personal and career goals as well why the applicant is applying for the scholarship.

The recipient of our scholarship may be asked to attend and speak at one of the Bluebonnet Master Gardeners Association's monthly meetings. He or she should be prepared to speak briefly about how the scholarship has or will help in attaining personal and career goals.
